Nifty COS syntax - set \$listbuild(multiple, variables) = list

(Possibly?) little-known fact: It's possible to use \$ListBuild on the left hand side of the equals sign in a set command to extract multiple list values at once: set \$ListBuild(several,individual,variables) = list

For example:

USER>kill

USER>set colors = \$ListBuild("red","orange","yellow")

USER>set \$ListBuild(r,o,y) = colors

USER>write r,!,o,!,y,! red orange yellow
