Business rule doubt

Hello guys,

I've built a simple rule , as follows:

ruleSet name Rule set name =) effectiveBegin effectiveEnd

I when condition HL7.{MSH:Messagetype.messagetype}="ADT" AND HL7.{MSH:Messagetype.TriggerEvent}="A01" I Send transform
2 rule name disabled true constraint source=Service for input file, docCategory=2.2 1 when condition HL7.DocTypeName="ADT_A08" send transform target BO HL7
3 rule name disabled true constraint 1 when condition 1=1 2 send transform target BO HL7
- 4 rule - name Rule number one - disabled true - constraint source=BO HL7, docCategory=2.2, docName=ADT_A01
condition ToUpper(If(HL7.{PID:Religion})="NOT RELIGIOUS")
send transform BO Send Email
send transform User.TESTDATATRANSFORMATION target BO HL7

Thing is, in rule 2, the operation succeeds, the message reachs BO HL7, but in rule 1 it does not go through. In rule 1, I have two different conditions, but they are linked by an OR and one of the conditions is simply IF 1=1.

Do you guys have any clue on why rule 1 does not reach BO HL7?
