All responses are appreciated. I am new to both scripting and CACHE so please bear with me. I am setting up a nightly backup script for freezing cache then backing it up and then thawing it back out. Currently when I enter the freeze command I am getting a response of access denied even though my id has %all access. I've tried passing the userid/password as a parameter in the externalfreeze command and passing it from a file. I've used my id and lastly I used the <u>system</u> id in the file. What ID should I use for this or am I passing it wrong?

sample 1: .../bin/cache -s. -u%%sys ##class(backup.General).externalfreeze() <c: /temp/ogin.scr

sample 2: ...bin kache -s. -u%%sys
##class(backup.General).externalfreeze(username="????",password="????")
