How to add the case insensitive index to a class?

Hi!

Consider I have a class `Package.Data` with Property `UniqueStringValue` as `%String`.

I introduced the Index for this property:

```
Index ValueIndex on UniqueStringValue [Unique];
```

It works well. But if I try to check if there is an object with the certain value in code like this:

```
if ##class(Package.Data).ValueIndexExists(value)
```

this expression fails, if `value="value"`, even if there is an instance with `instance.UniqueStringValue="Value"`

How can I set the index to prevent saving case sensitive values in this class?
