What Is the Best Object Callback for Insert Operations: %OnBeforSave(), %OnAddToSaveSet(), %OnAfterSave()

Hi!

I'm saving object instance using RestForms.

<u>RESTFormsUI</u> calls %Save() for me, which is great. But I want to set the property CreationDate with the current date for every new record being inserted.

So object callback implementation seems as a reasonable option. I did the following:

```
Method %OnBeforeSave(insert as %Boolean) As %Status [ Private, ServerOnly = 1 ]
{
  if insert s ..CreationDate=$H
   q $$$OK
}
```

And it works fine.

But <u>Documentation says</u> I'd better use <u>%OnAddToSaveSet()</u>

What are you using for the callbacks in similar cases?
