## X000D/as a carriage return in HL7 messages

I'm receiving HL7 message containing the escape sequence  $\&Mathemath{\mathcal{K}}00D$ /indicating a carriage return. In the HL7 documentation I find that this is a valid escape sequence but when I read the intersystems documentation it states that only  $\&Mathemath{\mathcal{K}}0D$ /is valid.

What is the best way to work around this? I think that intersystems should change the UnescapeEx method in the EnsLib.HL7.Segment so that it complies with the standards.
