Consume data from websocket

I want to consume external websocket api, URL looks like this:

```
wss://site.com/ws/v2/?&token=<token>
```

Checked with external tool (Simple WebSocket Client) that websocket works and I can consume the data.

In Cache the relevant functionality is offered by %IO.Socket class.

```
set sock = ##class(%IO.Socket).%New()  
set sock.SSLConfig = "MyEmptySSLConfig"  
set sock.TranslationTable="UTF8"  
do sock.Open("site.com/ws/v2/?&token=<token>", "443", 10, .sc)
```

However I get this error:

```
ERROR #7109: Timed out after 10 seconds trying to open stream '|TCP|443|42881' [zOpen  
+41^%IO.Socket.1:IOT]
```

Any ideas on how Cache can consume websocket API are appreciated.
