## Node.js using SQL query

I am attempting to use Node.js to perform a simple query against the database using some identifying information to get the ID. This is what I am attempting to do:

```
var irisobj = require('iris');
var myData = new irisobj.IRIS();
var result = myData.open({ path:"C:/InterSystems/IRIS/Mgr",
  username: "USERNAME",
  password: "PASSWORD",
  namespace: "YOURNAMESPACE"
});
```

```
var result = myData.invokeclassmethod({class: "%SYSTEM.SQL", method: "Execute", arguments: ["SELECT TOP
1 ID FROM SOMETABLE"]});
console.log(result);
```

```
myData.close();
```

Why doesn't this work???
