How do I set environment variable for current process?

```
set env = "MYVAR"  
set s = $ZF(-1, "export " _ env _ "=2048m")  
set val = $system.Util.GetEnviron(env)  
zw val
```

Returns val="" because \$zf(-1) spawns new process.
