Are they stored in the registry? I found the Cache registry key, but it only lists the remote server address and not the ports.

Are they stored in an INI file? If so, I haven't found it yet.

I can push the client install via the very helpful CEDocs URL (https://cedocs.intersystems.com/latest/csp/docbook/DocBook.UI.Page.cls?KEY=GClwindowssilentinst)

But the remote server must be specified and, so far, I can only specify it using the Cache Client GUI. I want to specify it by either a registry merge, cli command, or file write/swap.
