I have a record map and batch class being passed to an EnsLib.RecordMap.Operation.BatchFileOperation.


They are designated as INFORMATION.FPL.Record and INFORMATION.FPL.Header

After reaching the operation it errors out with this message: ERROR <Ens>ErrGeneral: Quitting with error on Message body <u>5@INFORMATION.FPL.Record</u> / 54 because Status 'ERROR <EnsRecordMap>ErrNoBatchParent: Record with class 'INFORMATION.FPL.Record' and Id '54' doesn't belong to a batch' matched ReplyCodeAction 1: 'E=F' resulting in Action code F
