IRIS Python Native API - Documentation Issue

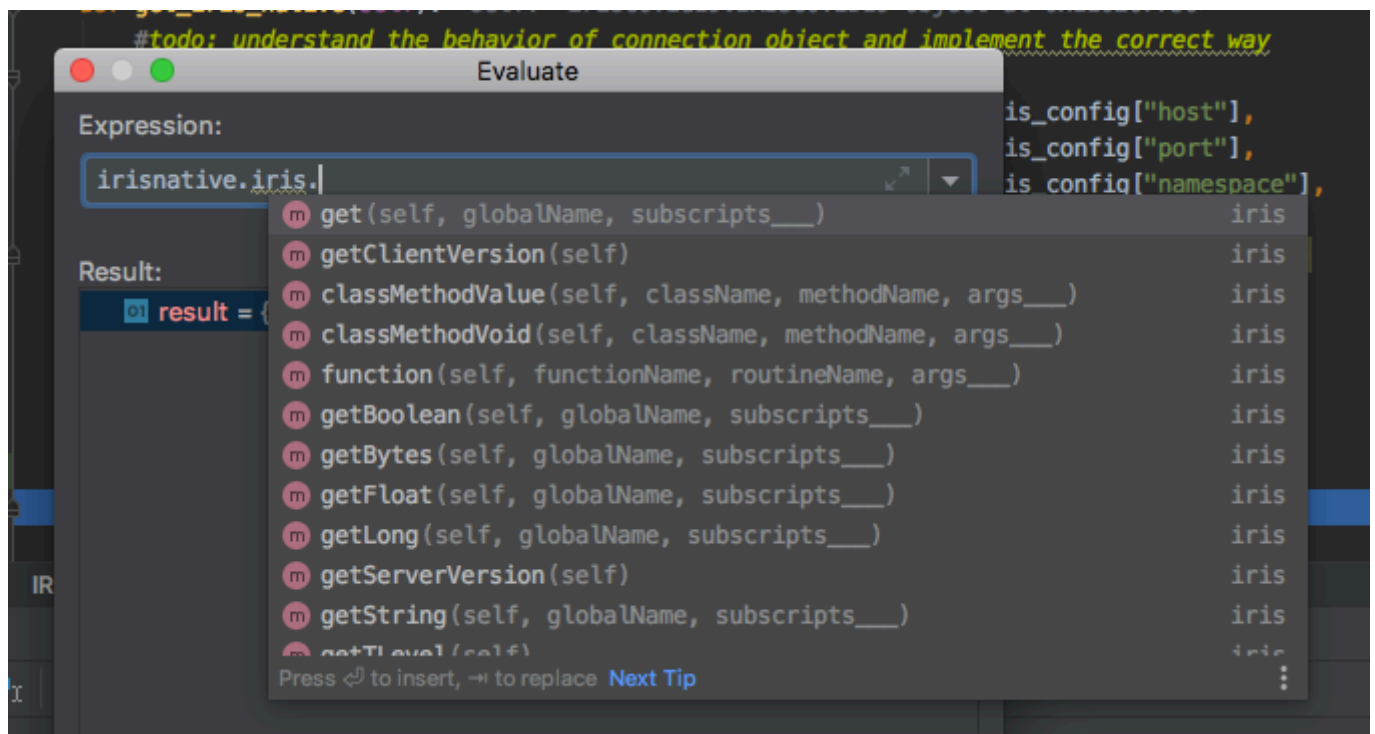
Hi everyone! I was using the InterSystems Native API for Python and following the documentation I tried to use this method

Looking at the object I can see the method: `irisnative.iris.getClientVersion` which doesn't exist in documentation (and probably does the same thing)
