I've started to use Task Schedule function in Caché. But I have two questions about it:

1. I want to run the task as an independent, technical user. What is the minimum resources for this user to successfully run the defined task.
2. I disabled the built in user `SYSTEM`, as the [Tightening Security for an Instance](#) article suggest. But I see that built in task run in the name of `SYSTEM` user. For example Switch Journal. How can this work, if the user disabled? Should I use another user for this tasks?
