How to add POST Body data to Net.HttpRequest

Hi, how do I add the POST body content to my [Net.HttpRequest](#) (It's not a key value pair, I am posting my own JSON to the remote server because it needs JSON in the body):

```
set httpRequest=##class(%Net.HttpRequest).%New()  
set httpRequest.Https=1  
set httpRequest.Server="redacted.azurewebsites.net"  
set AbsolutePath="/api/redacted"  
set QueryString="?operation=redacted&id=redacted"  
set status=httpRequest.Post(AbsolutePath_QueryString)
```

But how to add the Body to the request?

For the sake of this post, the body could be:

```
{ "MyKey": "MyValue" }
```

but in reality it's a highly nested, valid, JSON string.

I've looked at the API but can't make sense of it
