How can I export .cls files as .xml using vscode objectscript extension?

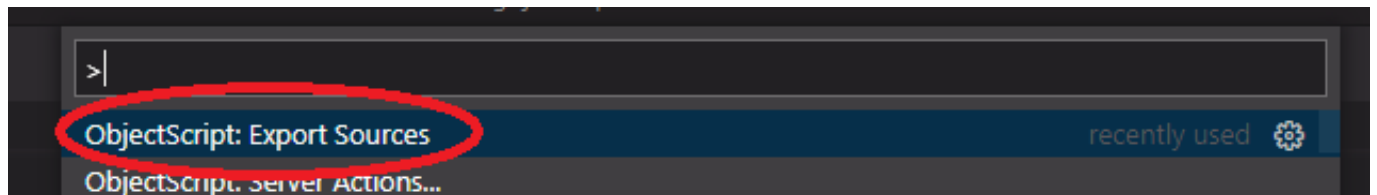
Hi,

When I'm using Cache Studio and save and compile some .cls file, it automatically generates the .xml file:
