InterSystems IRIS multistage builds

Images for other languages are often build using [multistage build](#) process.

What about InterSystems IRIS?

Consider this Dockerfile:

```
FROM irishealth-community:2020.4.0.524.0 AS builder
# Load code into USER and compile
# Adjust settings, etc.

FROM irishealth-community:2020.4.0.524.0
# replace in standard kit with what we modified in first stage

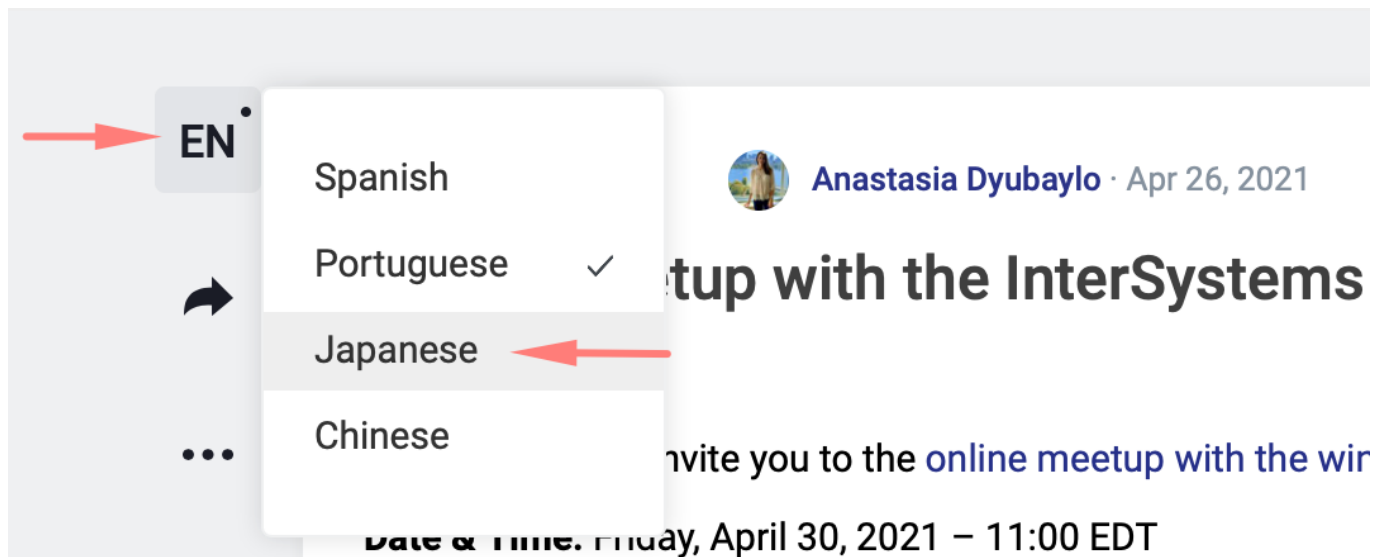
COPY --from=builder /usr/irissys/iris.cpf /usr/irissys/.
COPY --from=builder /usr/irissys/mgr/IRIS.DAT /usr/irissys/mgr/.
COPY --from=builder /usr/irissys/mgr/user/IRIS.DAT /usr/irissys/mgr/user/.
```

Post translation page

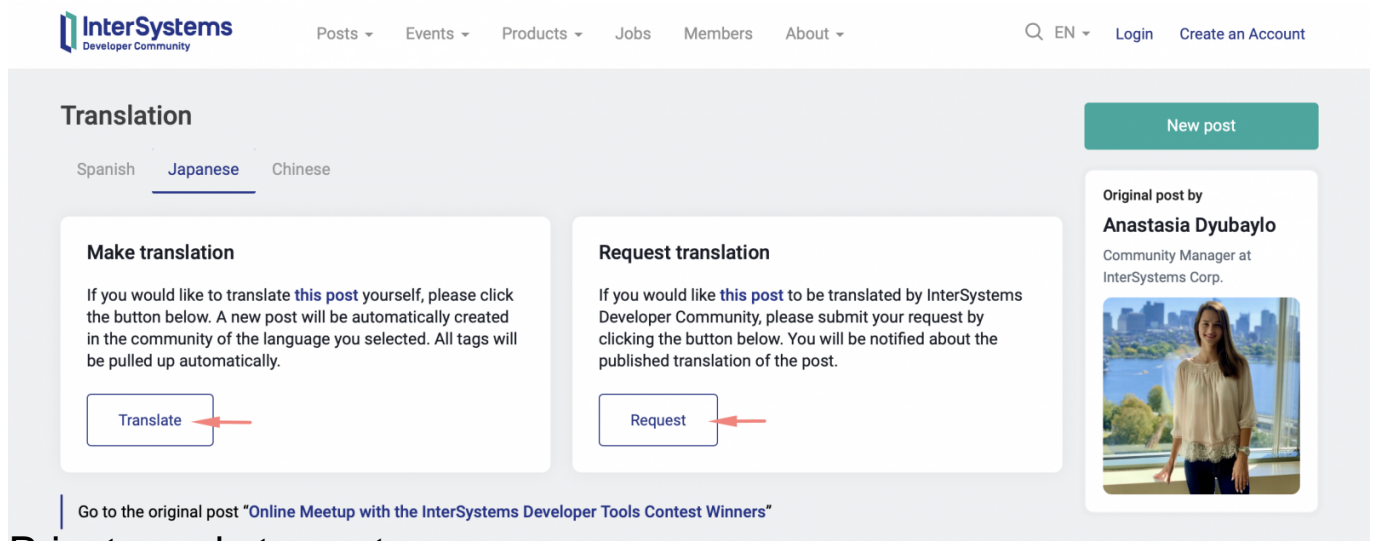
As you may know, on the DC site you can request a professional translation of the post you like or translate it yourself into any of 5 languages. To make things easier for you, our post translation page has been improved.

1. Select the language you need from the Language drop-down menu:



2. Select one of two options:

- Make translation – if you would like to translate a post yourself, click the "Translate" button.
- Request translation – if you would like to request a professional translation from us, click the "Request" button.



Private reply to post

Now you can easily send a private reply to the author of a post. Just click the "Direct message" button and a subject field will be automatically prefilled with post title.

{
}
```

How it should work

```
do ..setValue("key1", "val")
```

is equal to

```
set %session.Data("key1") = "val"
```

and

```
do ..setValue("key1", "key2", "key3", "key4", "key5")
```
