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STRING\$PLIT equivalent in Cache SQL

I'm looking for a SQL function equivalent for SQL server STRING\$PLIT. I have records like this:

jointotxhistory (key), ssnotemultidict1value (varchar)
64559.001

Assistant Principal, Case Worker, Client, Dad, Daughter,
Mentor, Mom, Other, Principal, Psychiatrist, School
Counselor, Teacher

and I like the field ssnotemultidict1value split to rows for each comma delimited value. So I can get this:

64559.001 Assistant Principal
64559.001 Case Worker
64559.001 Client
64559.001 Dad
64559.001 Daughter
64559.001 Mentor
64559.001 Mom
64559.001 Other
64559.001 Principal
64559.001 Psychiatrist
64559.001 School Counselor
64559.001 Teacher
