Problem with german Umlaute (ä,ü,ö) in \$ZF(-100)

Hello,

I created a custom business operation to copy PDF files in Intersystems Healthshare. To copy the files I used:

```
$ZF(-100, "", "cp", "-f", tSource, tTarget)
```

tSource contains the source file e.g. "/opt/var/data/dir/18210086871354229265849146876.pdf".

tTargetSource contains the target file "/opt/targetdir/MüllerJörg1821008687.pdf".

Copying files without german Umlaute works fine (e.g SmithRobert1821081542.pdf), but when the string contains special characters like "ä", "ö", "ü" or even "ß" copying is not successful.

Do I have to replace the special characters or is there a possibility to change the encoding of the \$ZF() function?
