Afternoon all,

Is there a way (at SQL level) to script out the definition of a Cache stored procedure from within SQL?

In SQL Server, I would do...

```
Select * from INFORMATIONSCHEMA.ROUTINES where ROUTINENAME = 'mysprocname'
```

But cant find anyway to do this in cache.

Note, its an old version of Cache, so "INFORMATIONSCHEMA" is not available.

I am trying to see the SQL definition in the sproc from SQL itself.
