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Adding multiple namespaces in an XML file

Hi

I'm using a class which extends `%XML.Adaptor` and I want to create an XML file with multiple namespaces, like the following:

```
<soap:Envelope xmlns:xsi="http://www.w3.org/2001/XMLSchema-instance" xmlns:xsd="http://www.w3.org/2001/XMLSchema" xmlns:soap="http://schemas.xmlsoap.org/soap/envelope/">
</soap>
```

However, I don't see how to do this with the code I have. So far, I have

```
Class
GMMHTIE.Docman.Messages.Request.RequestWrapper Extends (%Persistent, %XML.Adaptor)
{
    Parameter XMLNAME = "soap:Envelope";
    Parameter NAMESPACE = "http://www.w3.org/2001/XMLSchema-instance";
    Parameter XMLPREFIX = "xsi";
}
```

which produces the following, which confuses me.

```
<soap:Envelope xmlns="http://www.w3.org/2001/XMLSchema-instance" xmlns:xsi="http://www.w3.org/2001/XMLSchema-instance">
</soap:Envelope>
```

Can anyone help, please?
