Passing sql in as text to a command to execute .net

I'm new to cache, come from an oracle and sql server background. In oracle and sql server I could write basically a stored procedure like script and pass it in as text to the command to execute.

Example:

Below would be the `sqltext`

```
DECLARE @Id INT;
```

```
select id into @Id from something;
```

```
if @Id = 9
```

```
BEGIN
```

```
do something
```

```
END
```

The `sqltext` would work in sql server, what would be the equivalent for cache for it work?

I get a generic error when I try it with cache

```
using (var mdscmd = new CacheCommand(sqlText, MyConnection) { CommandType = CommandType.Text }) {  
  
}
```
