Problems to call procedure and return of an outputvar

Hello

I have trouble capturing the value from a stored procedures output variable from an MS SQL Database.

In the database querywindow of MS SQL manager, the procedure is called as: declare @return As varchar (100) Execute TheProcedure @return. @return then contains string of content.

From HC I call the procedure:

set RetValue = ""
set Inparm = "@return"
set Outparm = ## class (% ListOfDataTypes).% New ()

SET SQLQuery = "exec TheProcedure ?" (have also tried "{call TheProcedure (?)}"

SET tSC = ..Adapter.ExecuteProcedure (, .Outparm, SQLQuery, "o *", Inparm) set RetValue = outparm.GetAt(1)

This constantly creates errors. I have tried different variants but nothing works. Outparm is always null or empty.

Greatful for help with the right syntax!
