How do I return YYYYMMDDHHMM

Hi, I ' m using \$ZDATETIME to return the following

- USER>w \$ZDATETIME(\$zdth(\$zstrip("2022-03-29T15:10:00+0100","<>W"), 3,5),3)
- Output: 2022-03-29 15:10:00

I would like to return just the YYYYMMDDHHMM i.e. stripping out the seconds.

Does \$ZDATETIME have an option for this?
