No OnProcessInput() method in custom business service

Hello all,

I was looking at some code of a business service of which the author is unknown. It's very simple in what it does; it extends from `Ens.BusinessService` and has a method that performs `SendRequestSync()` to a business process. However, I noticed that the business service lacks an `OnProcessInput()` method. Rather, it uses a method called `General()` which has the same sort of signature/structure that `OnProcessInput` does--pInput as [Custom Message Class], Output pOutput as [Custom Response Class].

The method works as observed in a message trace but I am not sure why. Is it possible to have a method that functions like `OnProcessInput()` but is just renamed to something else? Would this be an example of overriding the `OnProcessInput()` method?
