IAM 3.0 Release Announcement

IAM 3.0 Release

InterSystems API Manager (IAM) version 3.0.2 is now Generally Available. IAM 3.0 adds significant new functionality including:

- [Secrets Management](#) – Save credentials and other secrets in HashiCorp Vault, AWS Secrets Manager, GCP Secrets Manager, or environment variables
- [Dynamic Plugin Ordering](#) – Specify the order in which plugs are run
- [OpenTelemetry Integration](#) – Collect & export tracing in OpenTelemetry format
- UI Enhancements
- ARM Processor Support – You can now run IAM on ARM64 architecture machines, include M1 & M2 Apple Macs
- WebSockets – Enable management of websocket-based APIs.

IAM is an API gateway between your InterSystems IRIS servers and applications, providing tools to effectively monitor, control, and govern HTTP-based traffic at scale. IAM is available as a free add-on to your InterSystems IRIS license.

IAM 3.0 can be downloaded from the Components area of the [WRC Software Distribution site](#).

The [complete IAM 3.0 documentation](#) gives you more information about IAM and using it with InterSystems IRIS. IAM is only available in OCI (Open Container Initiative) a.k.a. Docker container format. Container images are available for OCI compliant run-time engines for Linux x86-64 and Linux ARM64, as detailed in the [Supported Platforms document](#).

The build number for this release is IAM 3.0.2.0-4.

This release is based on Kong Gateway (Enterprise) version 3.0.2.
