## Why to run ISC Agent in Demo Docker ?

For quite some time I am bored by slowly starting Docker Demos from OEX.  
I type

`docker-compose up - d`

and after a few seconds

`docker-compose logs`

And I just see ISC Agent was started and is hanging around  
No IRIS instance is up yet.

To my understanding, ISC Agent is totally useless in this single server instance  
So with some investigations, I found a start parameter to avoid this behavior.  
And now my IRIS instances start immediately (or what you can expect in a container).  
What is it: `--ISCAgent false` applied in `docker-compose.yml`:

```
dockerfile: DOCKERFILE
command: --check-caps false --ISCAgent false
restart: always
```

Is there any reason not to do it if no MIIROR is in the game ?  
Or any other reason or requirement?
